#### Minutes

1. Public Comment
  - a. None
2. Update – 2019 Parking Permit Sales
3. Update – Transition to Pay-by-Plate Public Parking
  - a. Pay stations have transitioned to pay-by-plate configuration (2/4)
  - b. Mobile app anticipated to transition on 2/13
4. Request for Resident-Only Parking in Zone 2
  - a. Committee voted to deny for 2019, however areas west of Bergh Street are planned to be regulated parking in 2020 – residential-only areas will be incorporated
5. Request for Resident-Only Parking in Zone 1
  - a. Committee voted to deny the request. The City has not created any resident-only areas within the first two blocks from the waterfront.
6. Request for 15-minute parking space on Cookman Avenue
  - a. Committee voted to deny the request. Several 15-minute parking spaces already exist in the vicinity of the business
7. Forthcoming Parking Ordinance Updates
  - a. Reviewed draft ordinances for electric vehicle parking, 2-hour parking, new STOP sign and bus stops
8. New Business
  - a. Committee voted to increase the penalty for parking without a permit in a permit-only area from \$30.00 to \$50.00
  - b. Committee requested that the installation of bus shelters be investigated for all bus stops within the City
