



## **Parking Advisory Committee**

### **Meeting 2/7/2018**

#### Minutes

#### 1. Public Comment

- Resident 1 – what is the utilization of the Bangs Avenue Garage given the requirement for residents to utilize off-street parking in the CBD? Request to allow CBD residents to park in the garage
- Resident 2 – Approval of 24/7 resident-only parking, resident permit should specifically be tied a dwelling unit, not a vehicle, this would be difficult to enforce with current hang tag
- Resident 3 – Transportation Center and City Hall parking lots should be more clearly identified with signs at the entrances
- Residents 4 and 5 – Owners of the Asbury Inn on Seventh Avenue, all tenants are weekly room rentals, no leases, only sign a registration card. Would it be possible to provide a letter from owner to verify tenants?
- Residents 6 and 7 – Appreciate that the City paved Webb Street, curious about the plans for regulating the street, Committee to discuss regulation options including resident-only parking and paid parking, requested angled parking on Seventh Avenue as well, expressed frustration that residents pay for parking permits and that pro-rating of permits is not done, requested the Committee consider a contractor/temporary permit
- Residents 8 and 9 – repeating a request for a trailer permit (multiple permits for single full-time resident)
- Resident 10 – repeating request for 3 vehicles on one tag, resident-only parking around Wesley Grove

## 2. Residential Parking Permits

### a. Multiple Vehicles on One Permit

- i. 3 Vehicles on Hangtag – more to be discussed regarding enforcement

### b. Off-Street Parking Requirements

- i. Request for CBD resident to waive off-street parking requirement due to pregnancy – denied by Committee

### c. Asbury Towers Resident request for a relative caregiver to utilize the resident's permit rights – approved by Committee with some kind of verification for caregiver status

### d. Rental Cars on Resident Permit – more to be discussed

### e. Motorcycle Resident Permit – Committee approved a decal solution

## 3. Webb Street Regulation

- a. Committee agreed to institute resident-only on west side and paid parking on east side of street from Sunset to Deal Lake Drive, ordinance to be drafted for Council
