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City of Asbury Park Recreation Department Fall 2018 Programs & Events

9/7/19 – This fall, the Asbury Park Recreation Department will be offering sports, dance, and mentoring programs for the children of Asbury Park, as well as annual community recreation events.

“The goal of the City’s Recreation Committee is to create, and support, as many programs as possible to help benefit the children of Asbury Park,” said Councilperson, and Recreation Committee Chair, Jesse Kendle. “As a former coach, I know participating in these programs helps build confidence and self-esteem, and creates community. We are very proud of the work we are doing and encourage all Asbury Park children to participate.” Fall 2018 programs include:

Sports & Dance Programs

The **Boxing and Fitness Facility** offers workout equipment, treadmills, free weights and a regulation size boxing ring. The facility is open Monday to Friday from 4:00pm to 7:00pm. Annual Fees are \$75.00 for 18 years and under and \$150.00 for adults. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

The City has partnered with the **Asbury Park Technical Academy of Dance** and will provide scholarships for Asbury Park youth ages 3-17 to attend dance classes. Classes begin in late September.

The **Fall Track, Fall Volleyball and Fall Tennis Programs** are all 6-week introductory classes for Asbury Park children ages 7-14. Registration is \$10 and sessions will run from October to November, pending space availability.

The City of Asbury Park Recreation Department continues to provide financial support for the **City’s Youth Football Leagues** to help offset expenses and help ensure that youth are able to participate.

Mentoring Programs

The **Boys and Girls Mentoring Program** provides high school students with the opportunity to gain a variety of life skills – topics and activities include items such as CPR training, swimming, volunteering and job readiness. This free program meets weekly at the high school (girls meet on Wednesdays and boys meet on Thursdays) and starts up again with new school year.

Sponsored in partnership with the Asbury Park School District, the **“I Believe in Me” Mentorship Program** empower girls in grades 6-12 to use their voice, while building leadership skills and self-confidence. The free after-school program will start in October and culminates in an oratorical pageant in June to showcase their skills to an audience of family and friends.
