## PAY BY SPACE PARKING

This type of system assigns numbers to parking spaces (usually painted on the ground). Note the number and proceed to the meter and purchase the amount of time you'll need. A benefit of this system is that you don't have to return to your vehicle and display the receipt on your dashboard.

**Purchase Daily Beach Passes** at meter. Take receipt to beach ticket booth, and exchange for your beach pass.

**Enter your Space Number,** Make Payment, Take Receipt. **NO NEED TO RETURN TO CAR TO PLACE RECEIPT ON DASHBOARD.**

**Battery powered with Solar Panel recharge**

**Add Time to your Existing Space at Any Meter.** Your receipt provides you with the time your parking expires and your space number.

## NEW PARKING SIGNS



New street signs using the blue "P" icon (pictured to right) will designate the areas where the pay-by-space street parking is in effect. Additional signs using the blue "P" icon will also be used to direct you to the nearest meter.

THE ASBURY PARK PARKING UTILITY (APPU) IS EXPANDING THE PAY BY SPACE METERED PARKING AREAS IN THE WATERFRONT STARTING MAY 27, 2011. APPU WILL INTRODUCE METERED PARKING TO THE CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT (CBD) IN SEPTEMBER 2011, AND TO MAIN STREET IN 2012.

**In the Waterfront Area,** the metered areas will now include the 100 and 200 blocks of Asbury Avenue, First Avenue, Second Avenue, Third Avenue, Fourth Avenue, Fifth Avenue, Sunset Avenue, Sixth Avenue, Seventh Avenue, Eighth Avenue, and Deal Lake Drive. It will also include Ocean Avenue and Kingsley Street (from Asbury Avenue to Deal Lake Drive). Cookman Avenue (Kingsley Street to Grand Avenue), Lake Avenue (Wesley Lake Drive to Grand Avenue), St. James Place (Lake Avenue to Cookman Avenue), and Wesley Lake Drive (Lake Avenue to Cookman Avenue) will remain as metered areas.

**The areas in the CBD** that will be metered are as follows: Lake Avenue (Grand Avenue to Main Street), Cookman Avenue (Grand Avenue to Main Street), Mattison Avenue (Cookman Avenue to Main Street), Bangs Avenue (Cookman Avenue to Main Street), Grand Avenue (Summerfield Avenue to Lake Avenue), Emory Street (Summerfield Avenue to Lake Avenue), and Bond Street (Summerfield Avenue to Lake Avenue).

**2011 Residential Permits and Residential Guest Passes** will be available starting **May 14, 2011** for **Waterfront residents, and August 15, 2011** for **CBD residents in metered areas only**. Permits can be purchased from the Utility's office located at 9 Main Street (across from Windmill Hot Dogs). **2011 Residential Permit fee is \$30.00. 2011 Residential Guest Pass fee is \$100.00. Permits will be limited to 1 permit per household. Residential Guest Passes will be limited to 2 passes per household.** In special circumstances where a resident does not have available offstreet parking (garage and/or driveway), an additional permit is available. Any request for additional permit will be verified by the City before it is issued. Proof of residency (such as a Tax Bill, or utility bill within last 2 months) is required. Permits will be available for purchase from Monday – Friday (9:30am – 4:30pm), and on the following Saturdays (05/14, 05/21, 05/28, 06/04, 06/11, 06/18, 06/25, 07/09) from 9:00am – 1:00pm. **Permits and Residential Guest Passes will only be valid in the Zone for which they are issued.**

**2011 Employee Custom Cards (ECC)** will be available for all employees who work in the metered areas starting **May 14, 2011**. Permits can be purchased from the Utility's office located at 9 Main Street (across from Windmill Hot Dogs). **2011 ECC fee is \$100 for cards which are valid from until 12/31/11.** Proof of employment (such as your most recent payment stub) is required for purchase. ECC will be limited to 1 card per employee. **ECC will only be valid in the Zone for which they are issued.**
