



Parking Advisory Committee Meeting 2/5/2020

Minutes

Attendees: Mike Manzella, Barbara Krzak, Jill Potter, Maggie Quinton, William West, Jordan Modell, John Moor

1. Public Comment
 - a. Ana Maria Martino – resident at 1501 Ocean Avenue has access to one off-street parking space and one vehicle but is not permitted to obtain a parking permit and feels it is unfair as other residents with multiple cars are allowed to park multiple cars on-street in the off-season
 - i. Recommends an off-season permit, also changing guest permits to be issued in the same day for non-permit holders
 - b. Backward Glances – two tiers parking permits, 7-day parking permit, another tier only in the Bangs Avenue Garage, survey the employees – interested in a reduced rate to park in the garage, \$60, \$60, \$30, \$30
 - c. Ernest Mignoli – raised question of attendance by Committee members, Mayor Moor responded that he did not believe that the resident attended the past five meetings, resident requested that automated emails by the permit portal not be sent at 5:30am, requested that two-hour parking be enforced on Main Street
2. Update from the Director of Transportation
 - a. Bangs Avenue Garage public parking hours have been expanded
 - i. Fridays 6pm-midnight
 - ii. Saturdays 8:30am-2:30am
 - iii. Sundays 8:00am-midnight
3. Review 2020 Parking Changes
 - a. May consider a survey of employees regarding tiers of 7-day employee permits, garage vs. on-street
 - b. Committee agreed to lower the cost of employee permits for the third and fourth quarters
4. Discuss potential regulation changes to support construction of the downtown parking garage
 - a. Committee recommended no changes to the City Hall Lot
 - b. Ordinance already adopted for metered parking in Memorial Drive Lot
