Report from Station Director Nate McCallister –

New Switching system - the proposed new switching system updated. It will not require a laptop and will work with a new wireless camera and can be used remotely.

He suggests that APTV buy a display tent for use at events for recording interviews

Repair of the Panasonic camera – Need to find a method of payment that does not require a credit card as the city does not allow credit card purchases. Possibility - buy a new camera.

APTV is now taping monthly meetings of the Deal Lake Commission at Interlaken Municipal Bldg. We will tape 11 meetings a year and will not bill the commission. The video will also be shown on the Ocean Twp. TV. Channels.

The new program schedule will be up on the TV Channels on the Saturday after the Council meetings.

The Roku and Apple TV Apps are now up and the new website hosted by WIX.com is coming soon. Ed Salvas reported the Sunset Lake Video is finished and is being edited by Antonio.
