1. Public Comment

- a. Residents at property on First Avenue discussed parking concerns
 - i. Visitors are getting ruder, no regard for parking, Boardwalk employees park for free
 - ii. Request to designate at least half of the street for resident-only parking
 1. Parking Committee agreed to investigate for 2019
- b. Resident at Wesley Grove discussed difficulty with parking office
 - i. Issue every year with obtaining a parking permit for adult children
 - ii. Requirements for getting permits have changed every year
 - iii. Believes residents are creating documents to meet the requirements
 - iv. Felt that the customer service of staff needs to improve
 - v. Two requests
 1. Allow for payment of multiple days, either by permit or on the parking pay stations or app
 - a. Parking Committee agreed to investigate options
 2. Resident permit parking for adult children
 - a. Parking Committee did not agree with this option
- c. Resident of Deal Lake Drive discussed parking concerns
 - i. Believes there is a great deal of tampering with permits
 - ii. Requested time schedule for when Presidential garage construction complete
